Maths: Fraction Word Problems

1. Mr. Usher is 184cm tall and his daughter Sarah is $\frac{1}{2}$ as tall as him. How tall is Sarah?
2. Skateboards cost \$36 each in my local store. The shopkeeper says if I buy one I can buy another for only $\frac{1}{9}$ of the normal price.
How much would two skateboards cost?
3. There are 24 hours in a day and scientists tell us that we should sleep for $\frac{3}{8}$ of the day.
How much time should we spend sleeping?
4. The local shop normally sells Mars bars for \$1.20. The shopkeeper says if I buy 3 I can have them for $\frac{1}{4}$ less than the normal price.
 - (i) How much can I buy 3 Mars bars for?
 - (ii) How much money do I save?

in 'tough' it makes the 'uff' sound and
in 'dough' it makes the 'oh' sound
